Ekone Horse & Admin Internship

Dig deep with the Ekone herd and learn all about keeping, caring for, and partnering with horses in some of the most natural ways that we can. This intern will be Jenna's right hand, and she knows heaps about horse management, psychology, bodywork, hoof care, feeding, herd dynamics, and yes, riding. Riding won't be the focus of this experience, but will be included! You'll also spend time in the office, doing some general office tasks, some data wrangling, and some spring and fall fundraising event wrap-up support.



An intern can expect to spend approximately half of their time doing horse- and admin-related activities, and the other half collaborating with other staff and volunteers in various ways around the ranch (assisting with burials if interested, working in the garden, supporting shoulder-season programs, etc.). There will also be seasonal shifts in how we spend our time & energy, both with the horses and in the office—we'll talk about what to expect during the application process!

Regular horse responsibilities will include:

- Feeding
- Thrush treatment (feet painting!)
- Keeping waters clean and full

Other horse-related activities could include, based on the needs of the horses:

- Bodywork & massage
- Taking the horses on walks
- Riding

In the office realm, you might find yourself learning/doing:

- Data entry
- Project research
- Mailing preparation (letters & packages)

- A genuine interest in learning more about horses & horse management, including the not-so-glamorous aspects

- Sorting paperwork
- SPREADSHEETS! ;)
- Age 18+, with 1+ year of independent living preferred (college counts!)
